Kindergarten Registration is open for 2024

Kindergarten registration for all children in the Northwestern Lehigh School District who will be five years old on or before September 1, 2024 will be an online registration process.

The following documents are required to register your child.

- Child's original State Birth Certificate (with official raised seal) – child must be 5 yrs old by September 1st
- At least two proofs of residency (may be asked to provide more if needed)
- Proof of your child's immunization
- Custody information, if applicable
