6. Do **NOT** line up at the door at the end of class!! It is disrespectful and rude to the classroom environment as a whole.
7. Keep language and gestures appropriate to school. I expect by now you know the difference between the language you use at home and at school.
8. All school rules will be strictly enforced!! Do not show up late, do not be dressed inappropriately, do not use a cell phone (TXT messages included), etc.
9. Follow all guidelines in regards to the 1-to-1 technology program. Remember that using the technology in class is a privilege and not a right. Misuse of the computers during classroom time will result in loss of privilege and/or disciplinary action.
