- 7. Keep language and gestures appropriate to school. I expect by now you know the difference between the language you use at home and at school.
- 8. All school rules will be strictly enforced!! Do not show up late, do not be dressed inappropriately, do not use a cell phone (TXT messages included), etc.
- 9. Follow all guidelines in regards to the 1-to-1 technology program. Remember that using the technology in class is a privilege and not a right. Misuse of the computers during classroom time will result in loss of privilege and/or disciplinary action.
